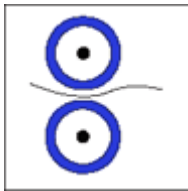


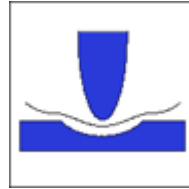
Geographics on Stewardship

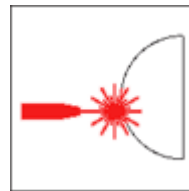
Pressroom

- No alcohol dampening systems
- No hazardous ink formulas
- Canister ink dispensers reduce ink waste
- Tote tank ink system eliminate drums for web presses
- Closed loop color control- faster matches, less makeready
- Automatic blanket washers cut solvent use
- UV light cure inks- reduce VOC's
- Water based varnishes
- All webs have pollution control
- RTO- 99% destruction plus recovery of heat
- Press wash waste uses as fuel by licensed facilities
- Lubricant oils are recycled
- Waste reduction training



Bindery

- Paper trim baled for recycle
- Corrugated collected and recycled
- Permanent totes reduce carton consumption
- Waste reduction training



Prepress

- Elimination of trace metal waste
- Switch to detergent based plate developers
- Elimination of camera film
- 100% recycling of printing plates



Office

- Recycle paper collection
- Office electronics are recycled
- Universal waste recycling (lamps, ballasts, batteries, heavy metals)
